1.0 Purpose

The Credentialing Advisory Committee of the JBG is established to advise the Board on the appropriateness of the Hospital's processes for:

- a) The appointment and re-appointment of the Professional Staff.
- b) The ongoing monitoring and supervision of the Professional Staff.

2.0 Policy Statement

Under the Public Hospitals Act and the hospital by-laws, it is the Board that is responsible for appointing professional staff to the hospital and determining their privileges.

3.0 Committee Membership and Frequency of Meetings Members:

- 1. SJHH President
- 2. Chief of Staff
- 3. One (1) elected JBG SJHH voting member (Chair) shall be appointed by the Nominating Committee as sub-committee of the Governance, Mission, and Values Committee.

Frequency

- The committee shall meet at a minimum twice a year, at the call of the committee chair.
- At anytime on the request of the Chief of Staff

Quorum

Majority of the members

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4.0 Committee Roles & Responsibilities

The Committee shall be responsible to:

- 1. Review applications for appointment and re-appointment that contain risk factors identified by the Chief of Staff or the Medical Advisory Committee.
- 2. Receive briefings on specific details with respect to matters relating to members of the Professional Staff with or seeking privileges at the Hospital.
- 3. Receive reports from the Chief of Staff on matters with respect to ongoing monitoring and supervision of the Professional Staff and assess the appropriateness of the processes being followed.
- 4. In consultation with the Chief of Staff and legal counsel, determine what, if any, information should be disclosed to the Board.
- 5. Review any other matter related to Professional Staff matters referred to the Committee by the Board.
- 6. Report to the Board on the work of the Committee as required.

5.0 Exclusion from Board Hearings

- In accordance with subsection <u>39(4) of the Public Hospitals Act</u>, elected board members of the Professional Staff Advisory Committee shall not be entitled to participate in any hearing related to any applicant considered by the Committee.
- Accordingly, it is the intent that the Trustee that serves on the committee will do so until the completion of their term on the Board.
- At any Board meeting to consider appointments and re-appointments of the Professional Staff, members of the Credentialing Advisory Committee shall recuse themselves from the portion of the meeting related to such appointments and re-appointments.
