4. REPORTS	
4.1 REPORT OF CHAIR	 N. Ahuja was welcomed to her first meeting of the JBG in her role as President, Medical Staff Association.
4.2 REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT AND CEO SJHS	 SJHS is looking forward to receiving the Strategic Plans for the three JBG organizations (SJHH, SJVD and SJHC). SJHS is viewed as a provincial leader with respect to the Integrated Comprehensive Care (ICC) Program and it was noted that approval for agency status has been received. An update on Provincial government activity was provided. It was noted that A. Falconer will begin as President of St. Mary's General Hospital on February 4th. D. Wormald has been appointed President, St. Joseph's Lifecare Centre in Brantford effective immediately. T. Stewart travelled to Nunavut to meet with the Honourable George Hickes, Minister of Health and Finance, Nunavut. SJHS has been engaged in collaborative initiatives to support Nunavut since 2012.
4.2.1 REPORT OF THE DEAN, FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES 4.3 REPORT OF PRESIDENTS	 P. O'Byrne gave an update on the current activities in the Faculty of Health Sciences. Noted that McMaster FHS has achieved excellent standing in world university rankings. Discussion occurred with respect to the ramifications of lowering tuition fees at Ontario universities, which was recently announced by the Government of Ontario. For the first time in its history, McMaster will be embarking on a very exciting fundraising campaign to raise funds for research endeavors.
4.3.1 Update on SJVD – C. Gosse	 An update on the SJVD hospice was provided. Noted that the slated date for construction completion is Fall of 2020. It was noted that SJVD is awaiting feedback from the LHIN on the application for palliative care respite beds.

4.3.2 Update on SJHC – C. Gosse	There was no further update.
4.3.3 Update on SJHH – W. Doyle	 It was noted that SJHH will be undergoing Mock Accreditation during the week of February 4th. This is a very helpful process to assist SJHH in preparing for its upcoming accreditation in May 2019. An update on the potential changes with respect to Local Health Integration Networks was provided. In response to a question related to Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROMS), it was noted that this initiative is being evaluated at the Provincial level. ACTION: IT WAS REQUESTED THAT THE JBG BE ADVISED IF THE STUDY "HOW THE IMMUNE SYSTEM ACCELERATES ATHEROSCLEROSIS, THE UNDERLYING CAUSE OF HEART DISEASE" - LEAD BY RESEARCHERS AT SJHH AND MCMASTER UNIVERSITY WILL BE PUBLISHED
4.4 REPORT OF THE CHIEF NURSING OFFICER	 A briefing note was provided on Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) training at SJHH. Background, current state and action plan were highlighted.
4.5 VICE PRESIDENT RESEARCH	There was no report.
4.6 REPORT OF THE CHIEF OF STAFF	 An update on the Tripartite Working Group, a subcommittee of the Hospital University Liaison Committee to review and provide recommendations with respect to the resident shortage was provided. Work is progressing well and it appears that many of the proposed changes will be implemented in 2020. An update on physician engagement in patient safety was provided. It was noted that various SJHH physicians have been successful in being awarded Hamilton Academic Health Science Organization (HAHSO) grants. An update on physician recruitment was provided. It was noted that SJHH has won 9 awards from the Canadian Institute of Health Research (CIHR). Suggested that a robust communication roll out occur with respect to these awards. ACTION: REQUESTED THAT THESE AWARDS BE ANNOUNCED PUBLICALLY
4.7 REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT MEDICAL STAFF ASSOCIATION	 N. Ahuja noted that the mandate of the Medical Staff Association is inclusion, engagement and leadership development. Noted that work is ongoing to connect with members of the Department of Family Medicine in the community to ensure inclusion in the various activities of the MSA. Noted that there is a need for leadership development amongst physicians and a leadership series will be presented through the MSA.
4.8 REPORT OF FOUNDATION PRESIDENTS	
SJVD FOUNDATION	 An update on Margaret's Place Hospital at SJVD was provided. Noted that tremendous support has been received by the community. Marketing/website enhancements have been updated and are "user friendly" allowing staff to make easy modifications with minimal training. The Enhancing Care Program was highlighted. The Road2Hope was held on November 3rd and raised over 20K. Succession planning at the SJVD Foundation Board is ongoing. Upcoming events were highlighted: The 18th Annual Gala will be held at Liuna Station on Friday April 26th. All JBG members were encouraged to attend.
