- 3.1 QUALITY COMMITTEE MINUTES, MOTIONS AND REPORT
- A patient story was relayed with respect to the General Internal Medicine (GIM)
 Program. This story illustrated the importance of providing clear communication
 with staff including scripting on how to handle difficult family situations, proper
 escalation processes and providing early engagement with all family members at
 the time of patient admission.
- Webex presentations on the GIM Quality Report, Patient Safety Priority: Improving Transitions for SJHH, SJHC and SJVD, and Patient Engagement Strategy for SJHH, SJHC and SJVD were highlighted.
- The monthly critical incident report was reviewed.
- A Dovetale Briefing Note was presented. The briefing note describes expected
 patient safety and quality improvements as a result of the implementation of
 Dovetale. Areas addressed included: clinical benefits, quality improvement
 plans and impact of Dovetale, and incident reporting system.

- Dr. I. Buchanan gave an informative presentation on Emergency Department Admission Avoidance – A Multidisciplinary Approach. Background, goal, resources, strategy, 2017 results, next steps and the patient voice was highlighted. It was noted that the impact of this program results in patient satisfaction, optimize and align resources, facilitate ED efficiency, provides value added admissions and decreases return visits.
- In response to a question, it was noted that this program currently operates during day hours, however there is a potential for expansion of the program in the evening hours.

	 Potential risk of a "too strong" mindset related to Admission Avoidance was discussed. It was noted that the clinical team carefully follows up with calls to patients with more fragile circumstances. It was noted that some patients, depending on the issues upon presentation, receive follow up care via phone calls post-discharge.
