MyDovetale Updates

1. Initiate Point-of-Care Authorizations through MyDovetale

If you linked your MyDovetale account with an existing MyChart account from another participating healthcare organization, you can sign a **Point-of-Care Authorization Form** prior to an upcoming appointment at St. Joe's. Signing off on this form will allow St. Joe's to query any organizations you have linked to your MyDovetale account to request your health information, as it relates to your upcoming visit.

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Test Results Details Page

The **Test Results Details** page is where you can review all the information about a test result and read comments entered by your provider. You can now see each individual component of the test result in its own card, making it clear what information is associated with each component. Within each card, you can see if the result falls within the configured normal range; numeric test results appear on a graph and non-numeric test results appear with the result and normal values for comparison.
