



When I lost my father two years ago to suicide it changed my life forever. A multitude of issues and questions which remain forever unanswered.

In trying to learn more about suicide, I discovered Fondation Suicide Action Montreal. They offer support services and a hotline for individuals and families in distress. A natural alliance was formed and I decided to create a project; 6500km Bike for Suicide Prevention. The bike ride began in Victoria BC and was intended as a fundraiser, to help raise awareness and to break the stigma that surrounds suicide. The ride ended in Montreal with hundreds of family and friends joining me for the last two days.

On my journey across Canada, I met Scott and became part of the Collateral Damage Project.
