3.1	<ul> <li>Patient &amp; Family Engagement Plan 2023-2025</li> <li>A summary of discussions to date on the Patient Engagement Plan was reviewed. Feedback from the April break out session was incorporated into the plan The Patient and Family Engagement Framework displayed the planned work and provided the structure of the plan. The three levels of engagement as described in the framework and list of work was explained in detail.</li> <li>Next steps will be to identify the areas of focus for 2023 and develop a plan of action which includes activities, goals/objectives and outcomes</li> <li>Focus on strengthening the area around engagement and partnership with direct care to ensure patients have a consistent patient centered experience</li> <li>Q: Have we achieved the goal of expanding the Essential Care Partner (ECP) Program to 8 additional units for 2023/2024?</li> <li>A: We have not reached the goal of providing the ECP pilot to eight additional units to date.</li> <li>Currently, we have introduced the concept to four units and are looking to identify another four units for the program.</li> <li>Q: Could patients and families involved in hospital groups contribute and provide experiences i.e.</li> <li>Breathing Buddies Peer Support Group etc. at the program level of engagement?</li> <li>A: Yes, hospital support groups across the organization are able to participate and share experiences to assist in informing decision making.</li> </ul>	M.
