

## After a Flexible Sigmoidoscopy

#### At home:

#### If you have sedation:

- ➤ Do not drive, operate machinery, drink wine, beer or alcohol or make major decisions for 24 hours.
- Follow your normal diet unless the nurse gives you other instructions.
- It is important to pass gas. Move around to help pass gas.
- You can go back to work and your normal activities the next day.

### If you had polyps removed:

- ➤ Do not have any laxatives or enemas for at least 2 days after the procedure.
- ➤ Do not do any heavy activities for the rest of the day. This means you should not do things such as lift grocery bags, vacuum, rake leaves or shovel snow.

## If you had a biopsy done or polyps removed:

 You will need to make an appointment to see your doctor. The results can take 10 days or more to come back.

### Contact your doctor if you have any new or severe problems such as:

- increased bleeding or bleeding that does not stop
- increased abdominal pain
- fever
