Hooking up your valved PICC at home for therapy

Supplies

- □ alcohol wipes
- clean towel
- D primed IV tubing
- □ syringes with normal saline
- garbage bag
- gloves. Gloves are worn if you have a cut, a rash or an infection on your hands.

Getting ready

- 1. Wash your hands.
- 2. Put your supplies on a clean, unused towel. Place supplies in the order they will be used.
- 3. Prepare the IV bag and tubing.

Hooking up

- 1. Put on gloves if needed.
- 2. Clean the connection between the PICC and the end cap with an alcohol wipe. Rub well for 15 seconds.
- 3. Remove the end cap. Allow to dry.
- 4. Clean the end of the PICC with an alcohol wipe. Rub well for 15 seconds. Allow to dry.
- 5. Flush with normal saline.
- 6. Attach the prepared IV tubing to the PICC.
- 7. Turn on your IV or pump. Set rate as instructed.
- 8. Secure the PICC as taught.
