Quinine Sulfate (Kwa – neen Sul – fate)

Other names for this medication

Quinine[®]

How this medication is used

This medication is used to relieve leg cramps.

This medication can also be used to treat malaria.

How to take this medication

Take this medication exactly as directed by your doctor.

To avoid stomach upset, take this medication with a meal or snack.

If you miss a dose of this medication, take it as soon as possible. However, if it is almost time for the next dose, skip the missed dose and go back to your regular time. Do not take 2 doses at one time.

While taking this medication you may notice

- headache
 - nausea, vomiting
 - diarrhea
 - stomach cramps
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Contact your doctor if you notice

- blurred vision or change in colour vision
- irregular heart beat
- confusion
- lightheadedness
- ringing in the ears
- red, itchy skin rash. You may be having a reaction to this medication.
- anxiety
- wheezing or trouble breathing
- frequent fever or chills
